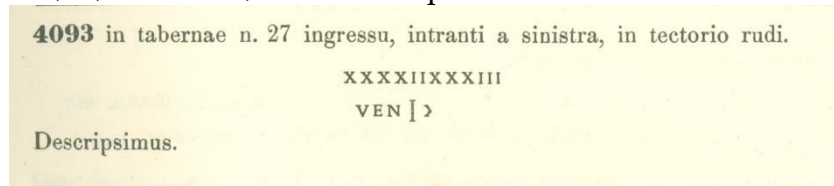


V 1,27 Taberna

In *CIL*, the inscriptions are listed under the heading *graphio scripta*: IV 4093; IV 4094.

IV 4093

V 1,27, west wall, north door-post



At the entrance of taberna no. 27, to the left of one who enters, on rough plaster.

XXXXIIXXXIII

veni>

We recorded.

Commentary: the Roman numerals can be divided in various ways. Some possible transcriptions are

10, 32, 33

20, 22, 33

42, 33

10, 20, 12, 20, 13

Translation: Come! / I came / I was sold

Commentary: *veni* is 2nd person singular imperative or 1st person singular perfect of *venio*, 'to come', it can also be a contraction of *venii*, 1st person singular perfect of *veneo*, 'to be sold', 'to be for sale'.

4094 in eiusdem tabernae pariete anteriore, intranti a sinistra, in tectorio rudi.

Descripsimus.

In the same taberna, on the front wall, to the left of one who enters, on rough plaster.
