Translation: Come! / I came / I was sold

*Commentary: veni* is 2nd person singular imperative or 1st person singular perfect of *venio,* 'to come', it can also be a contraction of *venii,* 1st person singular perfect of *veneo,* 'to be sold', 'to be for sale'.
